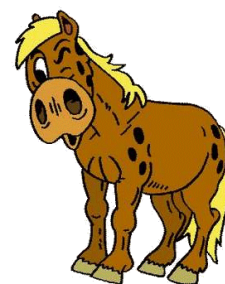




Put in the correct form of the verbs in brackets.

When Jessica was little, she **loved** (love) horses. The family **stayed** (stay) on a farm. Their parents **took** (take) Daniel and Jessica to a horse camp. Jessica **thought** (think) it **was** (be) great. Their last pony ride **started** (start) at three o'clock. Daniel and Jessica **were** (be) behind the guide. After a time they **came** (come) out of the forest.

The pupils of class 6a **went** (to go) to school from Monday till Friday last week. Mrs Meier **didn't go** (to go /not) to school from Monday till Friday last week. On Monday and Friday she **stayed** (to stay) at home and **played** (to play) with Jessica and Katharina.

What about the pupils of class 6a? **Did** they **play** (to play), too? No, they **didn't**. They **did** (to do) their homework in the afternoon and **watched** (to watch) TV in the evening. Mrs Meier **didn't watch** (not / to watch) TV last week. She **read** (to read) a book.
